
Introduction

During this year's business plan consultation, 46 primary and secondary school children were asked to craft collages about "what makes them happy". Children made these collages with magazines, paper and pens.

Some of their ideas feature in our business plan consultation report, but we also wanted to show the full collages that children prepared because, as a whole, they offer even more insight into the number of things that actually make children happy. We have chosen collages that cover different thoughts here. Some ideas appear across the groups: sports, holidays, gaming, social media, animals, environment, kindness, family and friends, school.

Seven and eight year olds in year 3, have made collages showing what makes them happy including being outdoors and playing sport, as well as recycling and animals.

Children in year 4, aged between eight and nine, made drawings showing how family and friends made them happy, along with holidays and school.








Year 5 pupils, aged nine and ten, made collages featuring football, sport, family, money and being kind to one another.




Children in their final year of primary school, aged ten and eleven, made collages showing what made them happy including playing video games and sport, spending time with friends and family, and the environment.








Twelve and thirteen year olds made collages showing a range of things made them feel happy including friends and family, social media and sport.






