

Find your local youth clubs and activities

1

Visit your local council website

Find your local council by typing your home postcode into this online form: <https://www.gov.uk/find-local-council> and open your local council website. If your area has two types of council - 'County' and 'District', select the link for 'County Council'.

2

Find activities on your local council website

Search your local council website for things like: 'youth club', 'youth activities', 'library what's on' and, if you receive free school meals, search for 'Holiday Activity and Food Programmes'.

3

Explore your local youth clubs, programmes and venues

Make a list of things you would like to try in your local area (you could do this yourself or together with someone in your family) – this could include youth clubs, activity groups, libraries and venues and holiday programmes. Some of these will be free and some will have a cost to attend.

4

Ask your parent or guardian

Share your list with a parent or guardian and decide which things might be best for you to try. Get their permission and either contact the activity or go along if you can just turn up!
